GENERAL INFORMATION FOR GOLFERS

- Registration will start in the main ballroom of the club at 9:00 am on October 12th. Please register immediately upon arrival at the club.
- The driving range and the putting greens will be available starting at 9:00 am.
- There will be Long Drive, Straight Drive, Closest to the Pin, and Hole in One competitions on each course. Mulligans may not be used for these competitions.
- Only the first Hole in One on each competition hole will be eligible for prizes.
- There will be gross and net prizes for the Captains Choice competition on the South Course, and for the Two Best Ball competition on the North Course.
- The Captains Choice shotgun start will be at 11:30 am, and the Two Best Ball shotgun start will be at 11:15 am. Please be at your cart and ready to play by that time.
- We have a full agenda and a fun day planned for you, so we have set a goal of concluding play in 4 hours and 30 minutes.
- We will collect a USGA Index from all golfers. We will need to know your September 1, 2008 USGA Index and the name of the course where the USGA Index is maintained. Those golfers without an established USGA Index will be assigned a Day Handicap by LeaderBoard Scoring Systems.
- Men will play from the blue tees, women will play from the white tees, and senior golfers over the age of 70 will play from the green tees.
- A ball lost or a ball out of play should be played as a lateral hazard, with a one stroke penalty.
- Please indicate your preference of tournament format (Captains Choice or Two Best Ball) at the time that you register for the tournament. We will fill these tournament spots on a first come, first served basis.
- LeaderBoard Scoring Systems will be doing the scoring for this tournament. Representatives from LeaderBoard will explain how to use their scoring cards before play begins, and will gather your completed cards at the conclusion of play. Please turn your cards in immediately after play.
- Please take the time to repair your ball marks and divots.

CAPTAIN'S CHOICE RULES

- Teams will consist of four players. If you only have three players, then you will only play the tee shots and subsequent shots for three players.
- All players will tee off from each hole.
- Then the team selects the ball they feel is in the best position.
- From that point each player plays a second shot from the same location.
- This process continues until the ball is holed. There are no “gimmies”.
- Two tee shots must be used during the tournament for each player.
- The ball may be moved within one club length of the chosen spot, but no closer to the hole, and this must not result in a change of surface (i.e.; don't go from the first cut to the fairway, or from the fringe to the green).
- To speed up play, a team should not take more than a triple bogey on a hole.

TWO BEST BALL RULES

- Each player in the foursome plays his or her own ball throughout the tournament.
- USGA Summer rules apply, so please play the ball as it lies.
- Each player's ball must be holed. There are no ‘gimmies’.
- Only the two lowest scores (gross and net) for the foursome will be combined to make up the team score for that hole. LeaderBoard Scoring Systems Representatives will explain the use of the score cards prior to the beginning of play.
- To speed up play, an individual player should not take more than a triple bogey.

Again, as a reminder, please turn your signed and dated score cards in to LeaderBoard Scoring Systems immediately upon the conclusion of play. Volunteers will be on hand to offer any assistance you may require. The cocktail reception is scheduled to begin at 5 pm.
